MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTRY TO THE COURSE

- Age of 18 - 35 years (Student must be 18 years of age when writing SACAA exam)
- Learner will be able to swim 15 m unassisted in deep water while wearing an inflated life jacket, and independently board a raft from the water
- Before admission, English language competency will be evaluated by the approved ATO. This evaluation shall ensure that the applicant has a sufficient command of the English language to comprehend the content of the cabin crew licence examination administered by the Authority.
- Have a valid Class 4 Medical Certificate (We will assist you with referral for service provider for this or we will take you on an allocated day with the group to do your medical with an accredited provider)
- You must have the ability to show empathy, care, and ability to remain calm and composed during a highly stressed situation.

- A letter confirming employment.
- Recent 3 months' bank statements.
- A recent payslip.
- A certified copy of the South African Identity Document.
- A minimum basic salary of R8,000.00 (Eight Thousand Rand).
- A clear credit history.



You can contact us to get the consultant allocated to our institutions details to assist you. We will then forward the completed documents along with an acceptance letter to FUNDI Loans, who will contact the applicant directly. Upon approval, FUNDI will make payment directly to The Academy of Aviation, and the applicant will be responsible for making monthly payments to FUNDI Loans.
